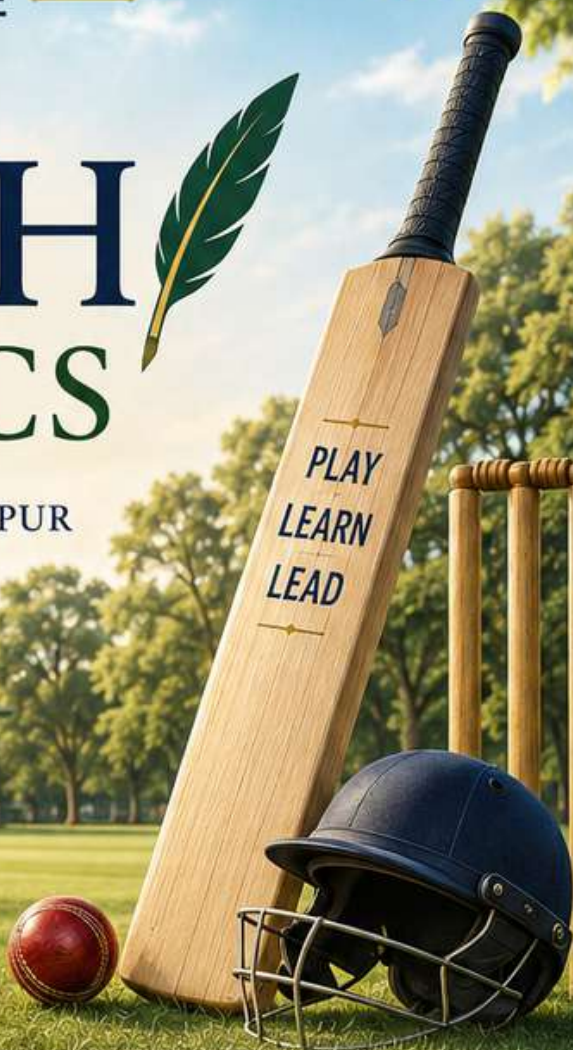

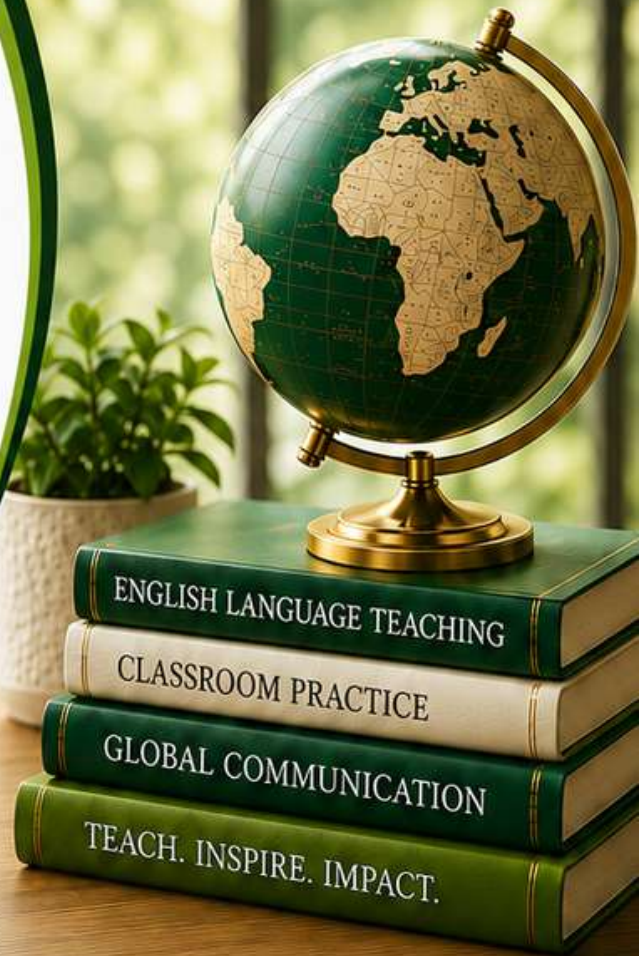

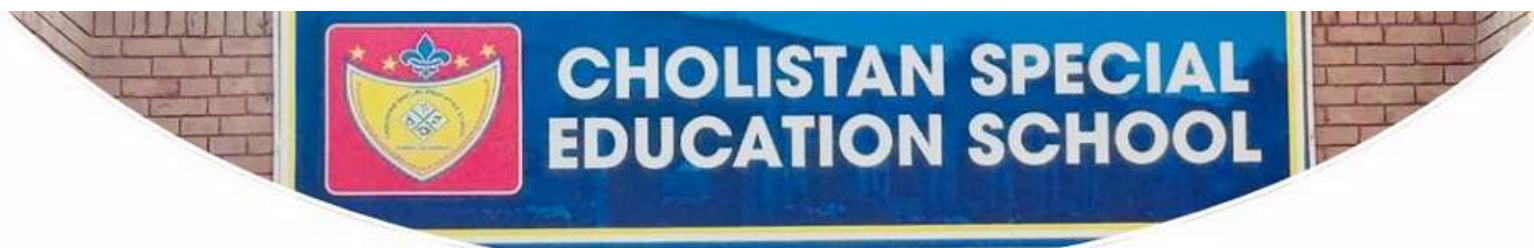


It continued with a motivating documentary on career development, which encouraged them to set clear professional goals and pursue growth-oriented opportunities with confidence and determination.
